

## Can I start a site?

We have a package called the “Facilitators Christian Worldview Curriculum”. This is designed with a Facilitator’s manual and DVD’s for all of the lessons. Nancy has brought in experts from all over the country to provide excellent material for each lesson. This curriculum also comes with a Student Worldview Workbook and DVD’s with all of the lessons as taught to Anchors Away students.

We recommend that this begin in January or February and continue through April. Depending on your personal situation, this will change from site to site. You could even do it over the summer. We recommend the final semester of the senior year because the kids are ready to get out of high school and excited about college. This gives them something to look forward to. The program is designed to work in conjunction with the friendships and personal relationships that they will build during this time. As noted above, there is a DVD for each lesson so you don’t have to worry about teaching them.

We would also suggest holding your classes in someone’s house rather than a church or school. It provides a little more of a comfort zone for kids who have not accepted Christ as their Savior. Also, for the kids who have grown up in church, we find that they tend to open up more in a “non church” setting.

If you would like to teach the classes then you would need to come to the training seminar in August. We do this to make sure that our teachers are properly trained and that they understand how seriously we take the doctrine and ideas in the curriculum. In the meantime, we suggest that you use the Facilitators Curriculum because it will allow you to have an Anchors Away class that you will facilitate rather than teach. The DVD’s for each lesson that come with this curriculum would work well for you.

To get things started you could:

1. Find a house, barn, community center, club house, etc. to meet in.
2. Tell as many seniors and college students in your area about when and where you are meeting. You can do this by sending and giving out flyers to the high school students and churches.
3. Find someone willing to open and close each session and couples (only has to be a guy and a girl, they don’t have to be married or dating) to help facilitate the small groups. We usually recommend 5 to 8 kids in a small group.
4. Many of our sites will have water/pop and cookies for the kids but this is in no way a requirement.
